**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE V OF CITY
ORDINANCE NO. 99/051 (ENTITLED: "THE REVENUE CODE
OF THE CITY OF MANDAUE") AS AMENDED**

The TENTH SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD of MANDAUE CITY, with members in session duly assembled, hereby ORDAINS that:

SECTION 1. Section 35-A, Article V of City Ordinance No. 99/051 as amended, is hereby further amended by adjusting the amount of charges and fees thereof to read as follows:

“SECTION 35-A. xxx

- a. *Seventy-Five (P75.00) Pesos*, regardless of volume or quantity, unless the shipment or shipments are covered by auxiliary invoice from the point of source or origin. However, the same shall apply to fishery and other aquatic products other than fresh fish.
 - b. *Two (P2.00) Pesos* per receptacle of fresh fish known as "Bañera" as inspection fee. This fee shall only apply to the inspection of fresh fish. A "Bañera" is a receptacle made usually of steel that looks like a tub because of its wide circular opening and a smaller circular base, commonly used in commercial fishing as the base of measurement for every fish catch.

SECTION 2. A new provision of Article V of City Ordinance 99/051 as amended, is hereby inserted after 35-A (a) and (b) to read as follows:

"SECTION 35-B. The owner of the shipment of fishery and other aquatic products must present his auxiliary invoice from the point of source or origin to the authorized personnel of the Office of the Fish Warden for inspection before a discharge permit will be issued prior to the transportation of the products out of the pier area.

In case the owner of shipment has not secured any auxiliary invoice from the point of source or origin then he must secure transshipment certificate from the Office of the Fish Warden of Mandaue City and pay the corresponding charges as provided hereof before the discharge permit be issued by the same office.

The Fish Warden through the Maritime Police Officer shall have the power to stop or hold discharge of any fishery and aquatic products out of the pier area unless discharge permit from his office is properly obtained by the owner of the shipment or by the latter's representative."



SECTION 4. This amendatory ordinance shall take effect on the date of its approval by the City Mayor.




